2022 Return to the Fear of the Lord January 2 – 23, 2022

I bless you today in this new season and for making the commitment to the 2022 New Year Fast. As we begin, we must enter with wisdom, knowledge and understanding.

"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding."

Proverbs 9:10 NKJV

We must enter into our 21-day corporate fast, absolutely clear that our pursuit of God and Returning to the Fear of the Lord must begin with a personal pursuit of what "The Fear of the Lord" truly means in our lives.

For months now there has been a stirring up inside of me concerning the Fear of the Lord. As we embark in this New Season, as well as this New Year 2022, my prayer, hope, and greatest desire is to see each and every one of us make a commitment to God and to one another to truly devote ourselves to the Scriptures. A commitment to seek them as we would seek for gold or silver or the greatest of treasures. Yes, as sons and daughters first, as the family of God and as His End Time Church, the Remnant making sure that our foundation is solid that we may stand, and when we have done all to stand! Through these 21 days, we need to make sure that any cracks are being filled, any weaknesses are being strengthened, and our foundation made new through the process of the fear of the Lord.

We must stay focused and connected, and we cannot be jumping from one place to the other. In building a house, you cannot put up the walls or put the roof until your foundation is sure and secure!!! We must take our time daily and prayerfully reading the devotions and understanding the holy Scriptures. We must ask the precious Holy Spirit to lead us and guide us. He is our Guide, Teacher, Revealer of all Truth, and the Comforter. He will give us the revelation of the written Word. Then, as we read the Word, the fear of the Lord will not be grasped by the mind, but it will be etched in our hearts as the Holy Spirit reveals it through His Spirit.

There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, And a Branch shall grow out of his roots. The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord." Isaiah 11:1-2 NKJV

As we individually build our foundation, and together begin to build each person, every marriage, every family, together we will be the End-Time Remnant Church. We will be unstoppable; we will be that Church that has been founded on the firm foundation, the solid Rock which is Jesus Christ and for the Glory of God!!!!!
